

HOW DO I GET INSURANCE FOR MY ABOVEGROUND TANKS (ASTs)?

♦ FIRST –

Ask yourself - If the ASTs are in use, and

- Do the ASTs contain petroleum products, and
- Is product in the tank offered for sale?

If the answer to all three questions is yes, you may apply for insurance coverage for your ASTs.

THE CRITERIA FOR GETTING INSURANCE ARE:

- You must be in compliance with all pertinent requirements of the Missouri Department of Agriculture;
- You must demonstrate the ability to pay the \$10,000 deductible if you ever have a claim:
- You must fill out and sign the application form and supply all requested documents, and
- You must pay the required annual participation fee and the one-time \$100 administrative fee for each tank.

If you currently meet the four criteria listed above and you wish to apply for insurance coverage,

◆ THEN, <u>EITHER</u> –

- A) FILL OUT THE APPLICATION AND SEND -
 - Evidence of how you plan to pay the \$10,000 deductible, if you ever have a claim,
 - One or more photographs of the facility, showing the ASTs, piping, containment or remote impoundment, etc.,
 - A scaled diagram of the site showing the ASTs, piping, buildings, dispensers, etc;
 - A calculation sheet showing the size of the secondary containment,
 - Leak detection records as described under Question 11 of application, and
 - Your check
